All other indicators e.g. access to education, access to health services, employment, access to legal protection are directly and indirectly dependent upon mobility of women. A huge disparity still exists between rural and urban areas in that the women under study were completely immobile, throughout their life cycle. A large number of women in the particular villages where study was carried out had never visited even the nearest town, not even for seeking medical help. This had several implications. It led to depression. They only went to their parental home. They had no medical facility. Therefore, they depended only upon unqualified doctors. As a result, women had poor health. Our research showed that carrying water was a feminine phenomenon. When we asked the men, they said it was a woman's job to fetch water. Women worked harder. This showed that women are stronger.
